A. HORSE PARK MARCH BREAK CAMP

B. DANIQUE HENDERSON'S LIBERTY TRAINING & TRICK TRAINING GROUNDWORK

D. HOOF TRIMMING CLINIC BY HOOF GEEKS BAREFOOT HOOFCARE, AMANDA BALEMANS, FRANCINE LABOSSIERE

- DATE: Thurs June 26 to Sun June 29 – 9:00 am to 5:00 pm each day
- DETAILS: This hoof trimming clinic offers you the chance to learn about hooves and barefoot hoof care, including how to perform a maintenance trim on your own horse.
Horse hoof problems like navicular, laminitis, and insulin resistance are increasing. This clinic advocates for a natural hoof care approach, emphasizing proper hoof form based on natural design and appropriate trimming methods to improve hoof health and potentially reduce vet bills. It also teaches horse-keeping practices for overall horse health and well-being.
